China's Going Out as alternative towards to planning in peripheral countries

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Competition economic between Capitalism x Socialism

(Main field of battle between these two systems)

(Lenin, 1919 and Deng Xiaoping, 1978: shift the focus from the military confrontation to trade cooperation and future confrontation)

(Western and Academic Marxism: “Chinese imperialism”, operation under “law of value”, “denial of politics” and positivist postulates)

Eastern Marxism (China, Vietnam, Lao, People’s Korea and Cuba: Marxism as a “Science of Political Power”)

Ways to Socialism in 21th Century:

(Development of productive forces, challenge to produce goods better than capitalists countries, fight for technological frontier, **dispute of world market** and offer a alternative to financialized capitalism)

(Our mission: observe the Socialism [mainly Chinese socialism] without petit bourgeois academicism, Western “check-lists”)

The Global South South Challenge for Development

(Development as a way to Global South to Socialism under mediation of National Projects)

(Peripheral countries can't create conditions for development and planning by themselves)

(Peripheral countries developed, historically, from trends created abroad)
(classical case of Brazil – 1930-1980)

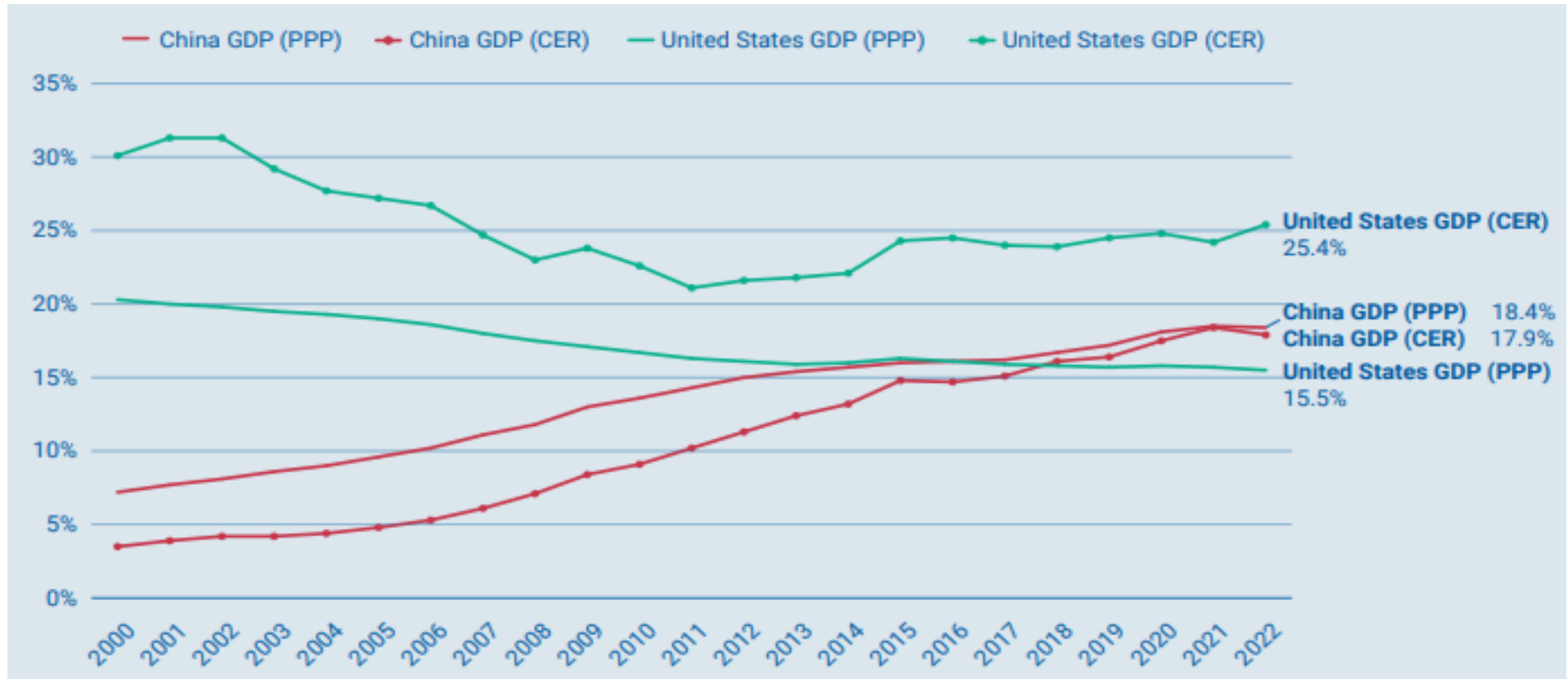
China's Going Global and Belt and Road Initiative [BRI] and the Planning of Foreign Trade for Global South)

(In the first time after Washington Consensus a great trend to development appear to Global South; China became a financial, industrial and trade superpower)

(China's Going Global and BRI opened room for a new round of development for Global South and, in other hand, a great imperialism reaction)

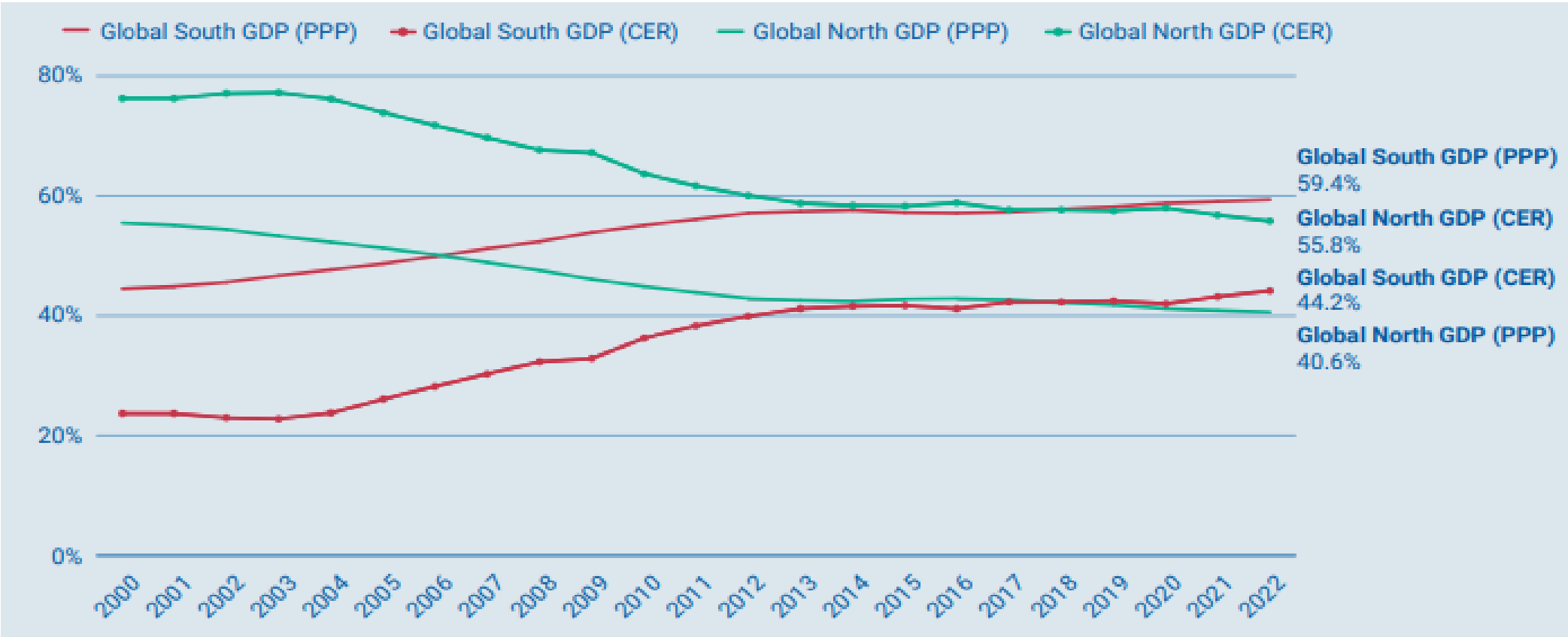
(The emergence of China and its schemes of foreign trade open the necessity of planning of foreign trade to Global South countries to enjoy these opportunity)
